

North London CVS Partnership – Networks (quarterly meetings)

North London Change Up Steering Group

Key aims are to support the Voluntary and Community Sector across North London to build and modernise infrastructure support in the six key framework areas: workforce development, governance, performance, ICT, volunteering and finance. The Change Up Steering Group is established to engage VCS stakeholders in the development of infrastructure services for the benefit of front line VCS service delivery.

North London Local Authority Funders Network

The NLCVSP invite Local Authority funding, commissioning and procurement officers to meet. The aim is to discuss the needs of the community and issues relating to funding VCS services. Identifying and sharing information and good practice.

North London Volunteer Network

The Network exists to bring together volunteer **infrastructure** organisations in the Voluntary and Community Sector. To support the strategic development of Volunteer Services in North London and initiatives to support community development. Meets quarterly.

North London Children & Young Peoples Network

The Network has been established to support **infrastructure** organisations for Children and Young Peoples Services. It contributes to local, sub regional and regional strategies and influences policy for the benefit of children and young people. The Network considers strategy, skills and resources needed by the Sector and works co-operatively to maximise opportunities and share good practice. Meets quarterly.

North London Workforce Development Network – New 2007

CVSs are now working to the new Workforce Development Strategy (March 2007). The new Workforce Development Network will engage organisations providing training and learning opportunities to other organisations. Working to support the training and learning needs of VCS staff, volunteers and management committee members. The next meeting is planned early July.

North London Service Providers Meeting – New 2007

The Network will engage VCOs interested in joint working with other VCOs in other North London boroughs and accessing funds from sub regional bodies that support cross borough projects. The next meeting is planned early July.

North London Community Learning Network – New 2007

The Network will engage VCOs that provide learning opportunities directly to the community. VCOs interested in or already working with other organisations across more than one borough. The members will be able to consider accessing funds from regional bodies like the LDA and LSC.
